A proposal for a remote compost drop off site at your location.

Elm City Compost is dedicated to bringing sustainable waste management to the city of Keene and the greater Monadnock region.

COMPOSTING MADE EASY

Elm City Compost is interested in building a remote drop off service within Westmoreland. This would be as easy as setting up a kiosk along with a couple of 64 gallon totters at the transfer station.

Details

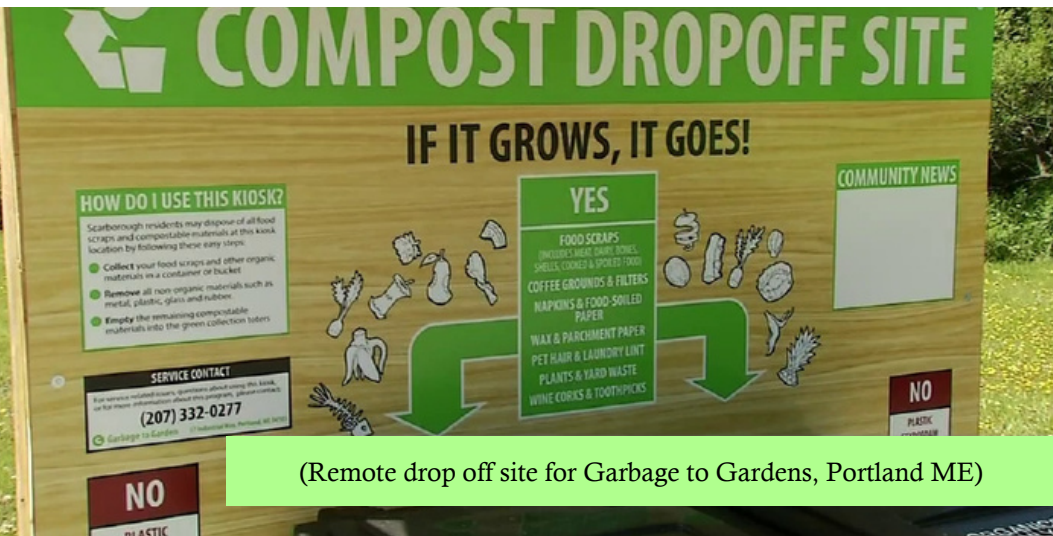
The Service: Elm City Compost customers would be able to bring around 5 gallons of food waste this site on a weekly basis. Customers would be enrolled in a monthly subscription service and would be able to drop their compost off with their trash and recycling. (Cost = \$15/month)

The Site: All that is required for the drop off site is space for 4 or 6, 64 gallon totters and a small pavilion like sign in order to detail the service (much like the picture below). Each of the totters would be equipped with a combination lock for proper management and pests. The site should be able to accommodate a truck and trailer easily enough without backing it up.

Management: Compost will be collected from this site on a twice/three times week. If needed totters may be cleaned or rinsed in order to keep everything looking good. Elm City Compost will have contact information posted on the sign in order for questions to be answered by our staff so as not to interrupt any normal proceedings

Start up: For a program to be successful, ECCI needs at least 50 confirmed customers to start. This would be a pilot program and the first few months would be to test the service to make sure it is viable in this location.
