- Certified Compostable Plastics

- 100% Natural Fiber
- Cardboard Egg Cartons

What Can't Be Composted?

Contamination

- Plastics of any kind- wrappers, bags, utensils, etc.
- Metal Twist Ties
- Styrofoam
- Produce Stickers
- Aluminum Cans & Aluminum Foil
- Metal
- Glass
- Shiny or glossy paper
- Dryer Sheets
- Chemically soiled paper (baby and non-compostable disinfectant wipes, paper used to clean up chemical cleaners/paint/machine oil/etc.)
- Bodily fluid
